RESOLUTION NO. R 10-39

A RESOLUTION SETTING FEES AND CHARGES RELATING TO PLAN REVIEW AND SITE INSPECTION AS PERMITTED BY THE BERKELEY COUNTY STORMWATER MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE NUMBER 07-07-44

WHEREAS, uncontrolled stormwater runoff may have significant, adverse impact on the health, safety and general welfare of Berkeley County and the quality of life of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Berkeley County is required by federal and state law to obtain a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control for stormwater discharges from Berkeley County's stormwater systems; and

WHEREAS, the NPDES permit requires that Berkeley County develop, implement, and enforce a storm water management program in its regulated area designed to reduce the discharge of pollutants from its small municipal separate storm sewer systems to the maximum extent practicable, to protect water quality, and to satisfy the appropriate water quality requirements of the Clean Water Act; and

WHEREAS, Berkeley County Council adopted Ordinance No. 07-07-44, which granted the County the authority to collect fees as a means of funding the implementation of its stormwater maintenance program; and


Whereas, Section 9.3 and 9.4 of Ordinance No. 07-07-44, provides that the County may charge fees for plan review and field inspections regarding the

stormwater maintenance program and such proposed fees have been attached hereto as exhibit "A," which is fully incorporated herein by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Berkeley County Council, in a meeting duly assembled, hereby adopts the Berkeley County Stormwater/Erosion Control Plan Review and Inspection Fees as outlined in the attached exhibit to this resolution and as provided for in Ordinance No. 07-07-44.


