

**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**TOWN OF MONCKS CORNER**  
**SPECIAL ELECTION**

The Board of Voter Registration and Elections of Berkeley County announces a Special Election for the **Town of Moncks Corner** to be Tuesday the 5th day of November 2019.

The following office shall be included in this election:

Town Council Seat – 1 Seat – Unexpired Term

Any person wishing to file as a candidate for the above listed office may do so by bringing the filing fee of \$100.00 (one hundred) for Council to the Berkeley County Elections office. This office is located at 6 Belt Drive, Moncks Corner, SC 29461. Books will be open for filing September 10, 2019 at noon and will remain open during regular business hours until September 20, 2019 at **NOON**.

The dates of filing are **September 10 – September 20, 2019.**

Council seat is an unexpired term, expiring November 2021.

The Special Election will be combined with the already scheduled General Election and held at the same time.

The polling place for this election will be Moncks Corner Town Hall, 118 Carolina Avenue, Moncks Corner, SC 29461, as set by law.

People desiring to vote in the upcoming election must be registered by October 5, 2019. To register, one must contact the Board of Voter Registration & Elections of Berkeley County.

Registered electors who cannot vote in person may be eligible to vote by absentee ballot. Voters wishing for more information concerning absentee voting should contact The Berkeley County Elections & Registration Office.

This is a nonpartisan election and no party affiliation shall be placed on the ballot.

The polls shall open at 7:00 AM on Election Day and close at 7:00 PM.

At 9:00 AM on Election Day the Board of Voter Registration & Elections of Berkeley County shall begin the process of examining the absentee ballots. This examination will be held at the County Elections Office, 6 Belt Drive, Moncks Corner, SC 29461.

On Thursday, the 7th of November at 10:00 AM the Board of Voter Registration and Elections of Berkeley County will hold a hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged in this election.

Any Runoff will be held two (2) weeks after the Election on Tuesday the 19th of November, if necessary. The hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged in the Runoff will be held on Thursday the 21st of November at 10 AM at the County Elections Office, 6 Belt Drive Moncks Corner, SC 29461.
