

NOTICE OF ELECTION

TOWN OF SUMMERVILLE

Notice is hereby given that the Municipal Election Commission for the Town of Summerville, in conjunction with the Board of Voter Registration and Elections of Dorchester County, will conduct the Town of Summerville Municipal Election on Tuesday, November 5, 2019.

Any person wishing to register to vote in this election must do so no later than 30 days prior to the election; Saturday, October 5, 2019. For more information about registering to vote, please visit <http://dorchestervotes.org> or call 843-832-0132.

The following offices shall be included in this election:

- Mayor (At Large)
- Town Council Districts 2, 4, 6
- Commissioner of Public Works (At Large, 1 seat)

Candidates for office who wish for their names to appear on the election ballot must be qualified electors, residing within their respective Districts, and file a Statement of Candidacy at the finance desk located in the Summerville Town Hall at 200 South Main Street. . The filing fee for Mayor is \$200.00. The filing fee for the office of Council member is \$100.00. **NO PICTURES ARE PERMITTED IN TOWN FACILITIES.** The filing period begins at noon on Wednesday, August 07, 2019 and closes at noon on Friday, September 06, 2019. The hours of operation are Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Voters who are blind, physically handicapped, or unable to read or write are entitled to assistance in casting their ballot. This assistance may be provided by anyone the voter chooses except his employer, an agent of his employer, or an officer or agent of his union. The poll managers must be notified if assistance is needed.

Voters who are unable to enter their polling place due to physical handicap or age may vote in the vehicle which they drove, or were driven in, to the polls. When notified, the poll managers will help voters using this curbside voting provision.

Registered voters who cannot vote in person may be eligible to vote by absentee ballot. Absentee ballots may be obtained from the Board of Elections and Voter Registration of Dorchester County. You may call 843-832-0132 or send an email to vote@dorchestercountysc.gov to inquire about the availability of absentee ballots.

At 9:00 a.m. on Election Day Tuesday November 5, 2019, the County Election Commission will begin its examination of the absentee ballot return envelopes at the Election Warehouse, 235 Deming Way Summerville.

On Thursday, November 7, 2019, at 1:00 p.m. a hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged in this election will be held by the Municipal Election Commission. This hearing will be held at the Summerville Town Hall, 200 South Main Street, Summerville..

On Election Day, the polls will be open from 7 a.m. until 7 p.m. at the locations designated below. The Poll Managers of election see that each person offering to vote takes the oath that he/she is qualified to vote at this election according to the Constitution of this State and that he/she has not voted before in this election.
