Cypress Gardens Grand Re-Opening Set for April 13, 2019

MONCK'S CORNER, S.C.- (Thursday, January 10, 2019) Berkeley County Government announces Cypress Gardens Re-Opening date for Saturday, April 13, 2019.

Due to the unprecedented amount of rainfall Berkeley County has experienced, crews were unable to do much of the work planned for the park. This caused delays to the project's timeline.

Cypress Gardens, located at 3030 Cypress Gardens Road in Moncks Corner, was severely damaged in the historic floods of October 2015. Berkeley County immediately closed the park. Since then, funding, timing and weather have all impacted the project, and kept the County from reopening the facilities.

Repairs and improvements to the park include work on the boat dock, walkways, bridges, parking lot, ticket booth, visitors' center, front lawn and more.

Berkeley County has done a majority of the work in-house with help from departments including, Facility and Grounds, Water and Sanitation, Roads and Bridges Departments and others.
