Cleanup at Former Viva Recycling Facility Complete

Under budget and ahead of schedule

MONCK'S CORNER, S.C. - (April 3, 2019) Cleanup at the Former Viva Recycling Facility is now complete. Drone footage from the facility can be found here: <http://bit.ly/VivaCleanup>

Berkeley County administration, officials with S.C. Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC), and County staff conducted a final walk-through on Wednesday, April 3, 2019 to evaluate the cleanup. Liberty Tire Recycling cleared more than one-million tires, or 13,540 tons, from the facility in 32 weeks.

Berkeley County Government entered an agreement with Liberty Tire Recycling to begin the removal of tires at the former Viva Recycling plant on Monday, August 20, 2018. While the company estimated the cleanup would take 40 weeks to complete, they were finished about eight weeks earlier than scheduled.

The cleanup was funded through \$3.5 million in grants from S.C. Department of Health and Environmental Control. However, Liberty Tire Recycling was able to complete the cleanup for \$3.3 million, coming in under budget.
