Berkeley County Bond Court Starts Video Bonding and Begins at Earlier Time

Video Bonding Begins April 15. Earlier Start Time for Bond Court Begins April 16

MONCKS CORNER, S.C.- (Wednesday, April 10, 2019) Berkeley County Bond Court will transition to video bonding on April 15, beginning with the 6:30 p.m. session. Bond Court will be held at the Berkeley County Magistrate's Office, located at 223 North Live Oak Drive, Moncks Corner, SC. This is where family members, victims, attorneys, media, bondsman and anyone else with business concerning Bond Court should report.

Effective April 16, 2019, Bond Court will begin at 8:00 a.m., seven days a week. Evening Bond Court will remain at 6:30 p.m. nightly.

For parking purposes, gate access to the Live Oak complex at night, on weekends and during County holidays will be restricted. Gates will open 30 minutes prior to the start of court, and close one hour after the scheduled start time for Bond Court. Once the gates close, visitors will be able to leave by going around the far side of the building where the automatic gate will open for them to exit.
