## **Resurfacing begins on Colony Post Loop in Moncks Corner**

*Final Resurfacing Project Recently Funded by CTC*

**MONCKS CORNER, S.C. - (Monday, June 24, 2019)** Berkeley County Roads and Bridges Department started resurfacing Colony Post Loop, in Moncks Corner on **Monday, June 24**, and are expected to complete the project by **Friday, June 28**. The work will be performed from Plantation Grove Boulevard to Care Taker Trail, including the two traffic circles. The map attached highlights the road work. Motorists should exercise caution around the construction this week. All work is dependent upon weather.

Once complete, Colony Post Loop will be the final of four projects that have been resurfaced since May 2019. The majority of work on these roads have been completed in-house, by Berkeley County Roads and Bridges Department. The list below shows the road improvement projects funded with \$500,000 from the County Transportation Committee (CTC).

- Centennial Boulevard (Goose Creek)
- Discovery Drive (Ladson)
- Hamlet Circle (Goose Creek)
- Colony Post Loop (Moncks Corner)
