

**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**CITY OF GOOSE CREEK**  
**GENERAL ELECTION 2018**

The Berkeley County Elections & Registration Board announces the General Election for the **City of Goose Creek** to be Tuesday the 3rd day of April 2018.

The following offices shall be included in this election:

Mayor  
Three (3) City Council Seats

Any person wishing to file as a candidate for the above listed offices may do so by bringing the filing fee of \$300 (three hundred) for Mayor or \$150.00 (one hundred fifty) for Council to the Berkeley County Elections office. This office is located at 6 Belt Drive, Moncks Corner, SC 29461. Books will be open for filing January 18, 2018 at noon, and will remain open during regular business hours until February 2, 2018 at **NOON**.

The dates of filing are **January 18 – February 2, 2018**.

The polling place for this election will be the Goose Creek Municipal Court, located in the Marguerite H. Brown Municipal Center, 519 N. Goose Creek Blvd, Goose Creek, SC, as set by law.

Mayor is a four (4) year term, expiring May 2022  
Council seats are for a four (4) year term, expiring May 2022.

People desiring to vote in the upcoming election must be registered by March 3, 2018. To register, one must contact the County Board of Voter Registration & Elections.

Registered electors who cannot vote in person may be eligible to vote by absentee ballot. Voters wishing for more information concerning absentee voting should contact The Berkeley County Elections & Registration Office.

This is a nonpartisan election and no party affiliation shall be placed on the ballot.

The polls shall open at 7:00 AM on Election Day and close at 7:00 PM.

At 9:00 AM on Election Day the County Board of Elections & Registration shall begin the process of examining the absentee ballots. This examination will be held at the County Elections Office, 6 Belt Drive, Moncks Corner.

On Thursday, the 5th of April at 10:00 AM the County Board of Canvassers will hold a hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged in this election. This hearing will be held at the County Elections Office, 6 Belt Drive, Moncks Corner.

Any Runoff will be held two (2) weeks after the Election on Tuesday the 17<sup>th</sup> of April, if necessary. The Hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged in the Runoff will be held on Thursday the 19<sup>th</sup> of April at the County Elections Office, 6 Belt Drive, Moncks Corner.
